It's springtime in Paris and Bernard (John Blanchette), a self-proclaimed Parisian lothario, has three beautiful stewardess fiancées (Kate Johnson, Jessica Libby, and Allison McCann) and a fine tuned schedule to keep them. However, the release of a new, faster jet causes the airlines to change their flight schedules and brings all three women to Paris, and Bernard's apartment, at the same time. Throw in an uninvited house guest (Zack Handlen) and a cranky French housekeeper (Megan Cross) and you're in for a wild ride!

The Portland Players are honored to welcome back director, Paul J. Bell, who was awarded "Best Director of a Play" by Broadway World Maine for his work on the Portland Players production of *The Prime of Miss Jean Brodie* last season.

Boeing Boeing, written by Marc Camoletti and translated by Beverly Cross and Francis Evans, is the fourth show of The Portland Players 2017-18 Season. The play was originally staged on Broadway in 1965 and the 2008 Broadway revival won two Tony Awards (Best Revival of a Play, Best Actor in a Play - Mark Rylance).
